

Brandon brewhouse Red Clover Ale builds community

BRANDON - Pete Brooks, 35, Andrew Gates, 39, and Riker Wikoff, 33, who together founded Brandon's Red Clover Ale Co., are about to make their about running Red Clover. 250th batch of beer.

Their timing didn't make it easy. The milestone approaches after several years of reconstruction on Route 7 through the downtown followed by a couple years dampened by COVID-19. The trio considers this their first "normal" year since opening the Central Street brewery in 2018.

"The town was under construction for our first year," Brooks said. "Having that be our first year, we were always kind of amazed that people could even get to us."

Things were looking good for the brewery following the completion of construction, but shortly thereafter COVID hit.

At the time, the brewery had just received its second national accolade: It was designated a USA Today top 10 new brewery, which came just two years following a similar award from Hop Culture Magazine.

The good news, then, was that craft beer lovers knew Red Clover was brewing some of the best beer in the nation. The not-so-good news, said Red Clover's owners, was that the pandemic seriously affected the community atmosphere they cherish.

When they were forced to close their doors to the public, they say their sales remained steady, but the sense of community temporarily faded and forced new tactics.

"We just started packaging everything," Wikoff said.

Instead of the conversations and the face-time with customers the owners value, their days were pickup and online or over-thephone orders.

As COVID restrictions eased, Brooks, Gates and Wikoff opened a beer garden across the street in Green Park.

With the pandemic officially over, the trio has been able to reestablish a strong sense of community in their taproom - one of the aspects they love

Today, their slate-blue, red clover-covered, farm-inspired space is filled with liveliness.

On Thursdays, a small corner of the taproom becomes a stage for open mic night: "Every Thursday, 6 to 8:30, sometimes nine," Gates said, adding the number of performances can range from five to 20.

The openmic night has even been the origin story for some local bands.

drummer Walter, is like drumming for every band. Anyone who wants to play a show, they're like, hey, will you drum for me," Gates said.

He recalled a recent open mic where somebody performed with unique accompaniment her baby on her back.

This anecdote is testament to the family atmosphere the Red Clover taproom touts. The brewery encourages families with children to come in, and add to the family vibe by bringing their own kids to join the fun.

"We all have young kids," filled with growler fills, curbside Wikoff said. "We want it to be a space that you can bring your kids to."

Adding to the family atmosphere, Gates's 9-yearold daughter has already been recruited to help out.

"My daughter works with me most Saturdays ... so she'll run the register and do tables," Gates said.

"She makes sure to point out her Tip Jar too," Brooks chimed

On Fridays the brewery normally hosts trivia, while Saturday features food, music and beer gardens "as often as ... we can." Meanwhile, Sunday afternoons are for board games - an underrated event.

"We don't really get to talk about it enough ... We signed "It's a really incredible amount out a bunch of board games from

> available. And it's kind of like a day just to hang out, play board games, drink some beer... plus we'll have a DJ work on those days,' Gates said.

Their small staff is one attribute they feel sets them apart.

"It's just us," said Brooks, "The open mic, sort of house adding," I think people like when they come here that it's one of the three of us that they're chatting with each time."

> Other than the three owners, the brewery has one other employee.

"We just hired an employee for Sundays, but she's awesome too," Brooks said.

GET TO KNOW YOU

Gates reiterated the value of getting to talk face-to-face with customers.

"You buy beer on a shelf, you have no idea what it's gonna be like, you have no idea what you're gonna be tasting, what's

"drinkability" of their beer also sets them apart. He says part of this comes from not trying to fit any specific niche.

"A lot of places always strive to go through, like the extremes of a style or like have a flavor. Rather than targeting the extremes, our target is just (producing) the best example of that (a style)."

"We have some very low alcohol beers, we have IPAs, we have pils ... drinkability is such an important thing. It's great to have that random 12% IPA, but most times, I want a 5.5% beer that I can just drink a couple of."

Gates says the of focusing on the beer's "drinkability" is "really awesome."

"It makes it so that even the people that come in on a daily basis, are true regulars, they don't get sick of our beer."

THOUGHTS OF EXPANSION?

With the taproom busy and their beers earning national accolades, is the brewery

considering expansion? Maybe. "Trying to figure out the best way to (expand) isn't easy... because we love the model we have set up right now, lifestyle wise, and just not feeling like we have to make a certain amount of beer," Brooks said.

But expansion could mean a few more places to pick up their product.

"If we increase productivity ... we'll have some additional beer to be able to distribute out. Probably still be limited," said Gates, as he contemplated the prospect.

But, he added, they're not keen to grow out of their current location.

"We would like to keep this Taproom as long as we can. We really love this Taproom."

BJ's Farm Supply in Panton is so much more than a hardware store

PANTON — BJ's Farm Supply in Panton is far more than what its name implies, according to owners Mikayla, 26, and Robert, 44, DeGraaf.

"Anything we can get, as far as local goes, we try

to get," said Robert. "A lot of local meat, lamb, rabbit, chicken, pork and beef is all within five miles of here," his wife added.

And they get their quail eggs from even closer than that; They have a coop for their avian employees right out their back door.

The store didn't always offer such a wide array of goods and services it's evolved quite a bit since 1988, when Robert's parents opened the business.

"We used to be a True Value (brand) hardware store," he explained. The store then transitioned to more of a "general store" as the number of local farms diminished and the remaining farms began to opt for supplies to be delivered to their doors, even as those necessary supplies began to change.

Mikayla said the store's present-day offerings often prompt customers to say BJ's is so much more than farm supply, and while the store's name might be confusing to some (and they've considered changing it), their wide selection sets them apart, while keeping a strong, local identity.

Mikayla. Robert and Mikayla officially became store owners at the start of 2022. Robert, however. had taken on the bulk of the responsibility of running the business in 2018, and the couple stepped up to run it through the pandemic — a time when area residents preferred to stay as local as possible when shopping.

"Locals didn't want to go anywhere," said Robert, "so they rediscovered the store," added Mikayla.

Mikayla said taking on the store full time and dealing with the pandemic was a hectic time for the couple, but added it only became more-so when their family grew from two to four.

Just inside the front door, there's a bassinet for their two sons, a two-year-old and a sixmonth-old, who they bring to the store every day.

Mikayla says she's getting to live her dream by having them

"That was definitely my dream, growing up was to always be a mom and to always have my kids with me," she said. "Whatever I was doing, I wanted my kids to be able to be with me.'

Her customers have enjoyed their presence too. On the day we spoke, she said a customer had come in earlier just to sip some coffee and visit with the baby.

These interactions are the couple's favorite aspect of running the business.

"It's just getting to know everyone. Honestly, I think my favorite part is the fact that they become like family," Mikayla said. "There are all these aunts and uncles that come and hang out and chit chat. And I love that, I get to work next to my husband and have our kiddos with us."

"And there's the opposite side of that," Robert said, "where we have a seasonal group of people Basin Harbor, Button Bay, all of that little network - some of whom we'll never see again. But (the regulars) still come back every year and grab their necessities. So we have our core locals that keep us open from December to March, and then we have our new people come in every summer.'

All-in-all, the couple said, the customer base is a relatively tight local community with an interesting and fun mix of seasonal visitors throughout the summer — a clientele the store tries its best to cater to with its eclectic mix of goods.

BRISTOL - Rocky Dale Gardens is not your average garden center. As owner Ed Burke describes it, the Bristol business is "a specialty nursery that offers an experience, not just plants.'

The immersive experience that Rocky Dale offers is what Burke believes sets his nursery apart.

Located in a beautiful corner of Bristol along Route 116 east of the village near the road up to Lincoln, Rocky Dale serves garden enthusiasts both local to the Bristol area as well as those from the larger New England region. He prides himself on the fact that Rocky Dale provides "an unusual palette of plant material."

The nursery and garden center sells a wide variety of plants - around 12,000-15,000 flowering plants, trees, shrubs and more sold per year - on 5 acres. The grounds offer paths, barns and greenhouses for customers to wonder among and become enchanted by the plant life.

"We try to offer plants that are more difficult to find in the trade," Burke said. "We really focus on a lot of woody plants and woodland plants that are harder to find."

To keep Rocky Dale Gardens running is a collaborative effort among its 10 staff members.

"It's 'How can I help you?'" Burke said of his team. "We delegate the work, we try to teach people how to do things correctly.

"We hope it's a learning environment and a caring environment. I find that people who are interested in gardening, who want to work in this kind of industry, tend to be really p o s e d nice people. Everyone is really kind to each other, we all take care of each other. It feels like a family.'

Though he has owned and kept Rocky Dale Gardens running for nearly two decades,

Burke was not the business's first owner. Before him were gardeners Holly Weir and Bill Pollard. Weir and Pollard, originally from California, moved to Vermont in 1981 and ended up buying an old hobby farm that became what is now Rocky Dale Gardens.

After 20 years of running the business, Weir and Pollard sold the business to Burke, who had started a landscape architecture studio in Minneapolis in 1985.

In 2004, he had heard about the nursery being for sale in Vermont and thought it was the perfect opportunity for him to be close to his family, which was what he really wanted at the time, while also doing something he's always enjoyed.

"I went to school for plant and soil science and environmental studies and I've always worked with plants my whole life. And so, it was just an attractive idea," Burke said.

Running a plant nursery came with some unanticipated challenges.

"I have to say that running a nursery is very different from running a landscape business," into it with a lot of ambition but was quickly humbled by the amount of work it takes and how difficult it is to actually make a living in this business."

Despite the challenges, over his almost two decades at Rocky Dale, Burke has managed to make a variety of improvements.

"The gardens have needed a lot of work over the years," he said. "I've made a lot of changes in the way things were laid out; we built a solar array, we've put up the arbor, and we've continued to make improvements."

"Though we're not organic, we don't use any pesticides or anything like that. We're very concerned about the environment. We removed invasive plants from our gardens, which the previous owners had planted. So, we keep an eye on that."


Looking forward, Burke hopes to focus his efforts primarily on the gardens.





Sweet Cecily knows what you want

MIDDLEBURY — "It's a general gift store and I think of it as the town's gift shop because everybody shops here," Nancie Dunn said of the store.

Dunn, the proud owner of Middlebury's beloved Sweet Cecily, opened the store 36 years ago in 1987. Before opening the store, Dunn worked at the Vermont State Craft Center, formerly located in Frog Hollow Alley, as the gallery director. After working there for years, the building across the street had become available and she decided to open up shop there.

"It was time for me to move on and spread my wings," she said. "I did not want to have a gallery, I wanted to have a store accessible to everybody."

Later, in the early 2000s, she moved the store to "the heart of Middlebury," as the shop website states, at street level on Main Street where it still sits

visiting, frequent the shop. "I have been incredibly fortunate that the day I opened my store in 1987, it was a busy store. And it has been a busy store ever since," Dunn said.

The store has a wide range of clientele. "Lots of local people shop here, students shop here, parents of Middlebury College students shop here," she said. "People that work at the college, hospital workers. So, I think of it as the town's gift shop for that reason."

Dunn's shop is constantly evolving with a wide range of products being sold. Dunn's goal is for Sweet Cecily to have something for anyone who passes through its doors.

"We have inventory that is accessible, and hopefully wonderful, interesting, unusual for people to choose from," she said. "You can buy a wedding present here, you can buy a handmade bowl, you can buy a compass for kids. It's really

Everything in the shop is hand selected by Dunn herself. She has an eye for unique, unusual products that appeal to a wide audience of people and

"Sweet Cecily opened about 35 years ago and initially I sold folk art," she said of the store's early years. "And that trend had its heyday then. When the trend of primitive work ended in the early '90s and I moved my store up to Main Street, I took that as a sign to start selling different things."

As an illustrator, Dunn naturally gravitates towards images that are colorful and unusual. "The prices are very reasonable and the things that I offer are unique, unusual, fun, and lovely."

Dunn finds objects that appeal to a wide audience of people through a process that sounds deceptively simple -

"Sometimes people ask for things. Sometimes I see things online, sometimes there are new trends. I've spent a lot of time looking for new work," she said. "Looking around, looking online, looking at catalogs."

Dunn also strives to make Sweet Cecily an inviting place for everyone. "The warm and friendly ambiance is key," she said. "I think the location is fantastic, we have a back porch overlooking the waterfall which is unbelievable. And we have

wonderful inventory."

Owning and running Sweet Cecily has been a source of great joy for Dunn as well as all who frequent the business. She explained that even during the COVID-19 pandemic when the store was closed, she found herself coming in every day anyway because she missed it so much.

"I just want people to know how fun it is to have the store." she said.

And even as Sweet Cecily has occupied its spot on Main St. for over 30 years, being

one of the oldest shops in the community, Dunn said she intends to keep the store serving the community as long as she can.

"It's been an incredibly interesting, fun, fulfilling, wonderful life's work here. [It's] one of the oldest stores in town at this point. People depend on the store. I still have all the energy I've ever had to buy for the store and deal with the store," she said, adding with her vivacious smile that she'll be there several more years.
